We are proud to announce that Saint-Gobain has received the ISO 14001:2004 Environment Management System Standard certification on the 7th April 2010!

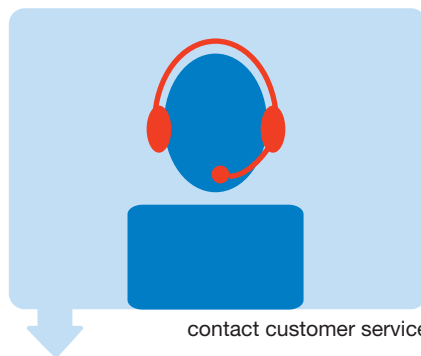

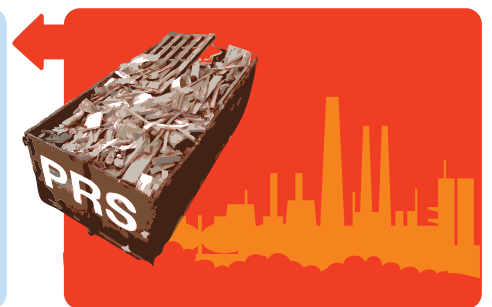
Plasterboard Recycling Service (PRS)
